## RULES AND REQUIREMENTS

All nominations for the AOSA Student of the Year Award shall conform to the following requirements:

1. Nominations are to be submitted using the online form. A statement not to exceed 1,500 words should accompany the nomination explaining the primary reason the nominee should be named as award recipient.
  - Anyone can nominate.
  - The nominee cannot be a member or former member of the AOSA Board of Trustees.
2. Supplemental information (i.e., letters of recommendation, curricula vitae, etc.) may also be attached to the online application.
3. The completed nomination form must be submitted online by May 15.
